### Access Plan

The construction of the site is likely to take around nine months, during which time access will be from an existing farm track to the north, using the A75 and A755, meaning that construction traffic will not pass through Borgue. The site will not be permanently staffed and very limited maintenance access will typically involve a small team of engineers every few months using small commercial or 4WD vehicles.
